Theme

The conference will focus on providing every man who attends the means to ingrain these three shared determinations in his life. Through expanding our state of life we can overcome any hardship, transform our destiny and inspire others to do the same. By expanding our friendships, we can create a new history of *kosen-rufu* in our families and communities, supporting a starburst of youthful successors for the next 50 years and beyond. As we share our mentor's heart to open the way to victory, each one of us can make a unique contribution to defeating all negative functions and forces of injustice which block the way to happiness for all humanity. By fighting to fulfill these shared determinations, every man can experience a genuine and tangible victory in every aspect of his life.

Historic Opportunities

The men who attend will have three unique opportunities to deepen their understanding of the oneness of mentor and disciple and how to make it the primary quest of their lives. This will be the first conference specifically for men in which the participants will view the exhibit in the new American Mentor Disciple Hall which focuses on President Ikeda's activities in the United States. Sessions that are Training Grounds for Champions

The sessions will include the study of Nichiren Daishonin’s writings and President Ikeda’s lectures with an emphasis on how to apply these teachings in our daily lives. There will be both large meetings for all the participants as well as small group discussions. These discussions as well as the informal dialogues which take place throughout the conference have been the source of lifelong friendships. There will also be ample opportunities to receive personal guidance from a national or territory leader. Experiences in faith will be shared by men from all over the country and related in ways which can only be expressed at a men’s gathering.
